Alice Watson aged 20

30th December 1844 Stafford Assizes, Stealing money from the person, Gaol Report – Character Very Bad.

Series – HO 18, Piece Number – 163

Received into Millbank Prison from Stafford Gaol on 3rd March 1845

The prisoner denies her guilt and prays for pardon.

To The Right Honourable Sir James Graham Her Majesty's Principle Secretary of State for the Home Department

The Petition of Alice Watson a prisoner in Millbank Prison

That your Petitioner is not guilty of the crime laid to her charge and was never in prison before. She therefore humbly solicits your kind consideration of the circumstances of her case and hopes you will be pleased to recommend her pardon and your Petitioner will ever pray.
