The Humble Petition of KATHRIN McKAY

That your unfortunate Petitioner is sentenced to seven years transportation for a very small crime , done by your unfortunate Petitioner when in a state of mental derangement with ardent spirits; and being the first offence before the High Court of Justiciary your poor unfortunate prisoner deeply regrets and is truly penitent for the crime she rashly committed; and humble, earnestly and most respectfully submits this Petition to the humane and benevolent and Christian disposition of the Right Honourable Secretary of State for the Home Department; trusting that your poor unfortunate prisoner will be allowed to remain in confinement in London or in any other part of His Majesty's dominions which are destined for the receiving of criminals for small, offences and your poor unfortunate Petitioner and prisoner will ever pray
