7 YEARS TRANSPORTATION

To His Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

The humble petition of DOROTHY HAMMOND

Sheweth that your petitioner is under the sentence of transportation for seven years and is innocent of the crime she had been charged with and that your petitioner has a husband and two children, her husband had been in the service of the seas for many years and is now expected to return from Prussia in a few weeks your petitioner humbly implores your Honoured Sir to be pleas'd to mitigate her sentence and permit her to stay in England till the next ship goes off with transports as it will afford your petitioner and her husband the opportunity of seeing each other once more, and painfull it will be to your petitioners husband who has been in superier services on the seas to find his wife so unfortunately confined within the walls of Newgate allow your petitioner. [H ] Sir to intreat you to shew mercy on her who with duty will forever pray.
