Honoured Sir,

I beg leave with every feeling of dutifull respect most humbly to address you on behalf of an unfortunate female who was convicted at the Winter Assizes held at Maidstone for robbing your Petitioner of 5/- for which she was sentenced to seven years transportation but through feelings of humanity in consequence of her penitence and contrition for past errors and a desire to alleviate the sufferings of an afflicted parent brought on by the unfortunate situation of her only child induces me to make this humble appeal to your kind and humane feelings sincerely hoping that your applicants prayer will not be in vain that instead of sending her abroad you will be pleased to get her an asylum in the Penitentiary, I have made enquires about her and I find that she once bore an excellent character and her poor mother an honest industrious woman who as now a heavy charge of an infant the mother of which is the subject of my Petition. Therefore trusting that you will be pleased to extend to her a small boon of your kind clemency for which your humble Petitioner will ever pray.
