At the request of this Court I beg to call your attention to this case of Mary Braunstone who, at the Quarter Sessions for the County held at Leicester this week, was convicted of stealing her Master's property while in his service at Loughborough, for which she had been sentence to seven years transportation.

Her age is only 16 and on account of her previous suspicious character, the Magistrate's are desirous of asking you consent to send her to the Penitentiary, as the best means of rescuing her from ruin.
