We have had a large family but this has nearly broken our hearts, since she has departed from the paths of virtue we have done all in our power to reclaim her, but to no effect she is now truly penitent and we would most humbly intreat your Lordship to get her admitted into the Magdaline it would indeed make us happy, and we shall for ever pray for your Lordship we also most humbly beg your Lordships pardon for the liberty we have taken and beg to subscribe ourselves your Lordships, we would humble beg to say we her parents can be well recommended as to character.
