

Caroline White per Hindostan 1839 - ID 6382

The humble Petition of CAROLINE WHITE aged 18 now on board the HINDOSTAN at Woolwich - She was tried at the Old Bailey on the 23rd October 1838 for the robbery of a house under her care, and condemned to ten years transportation. It being the first offence which she has been tried your Petitioner humbly prays that she may remain in England with her aged father and mother, who will ever feel bound to pray for those who may extend their mercy to her. The friends are ready to vouch for the respectability and honesty of her early life, she having been carefully educated and generally well conducted before she unfortunately formed [ ] acquaintance .
