To The Right Honourable Lord John Russell Her Majesty's Principle Secretary of State for the Home Department

The humble Petition of HARRIOT ANDREWS wife of HENRY ANSREWS of No 79 Long Lane West Smithfields London humbly represents that her Sister in Law MARY ANN ANDREWS late of Blue Anchor Ally Bunhill Row in the county of Middlesex but now a prisoner in Her Majesty's gaol of Newgate has been convicted of felony and has been sentenced to transportation for fourteen years. Your Petitioner most humbly represents that the prisoner although described as 55 years of age is really 62 years of age and has never been in custody before but had unfortunately addicted to habits of intoxication and which your petitioner verily believes has led to the commission of this her first offence.

Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays that your Lordships will recommend her as an object for the most Gracious Majesty's Clemency by commuting her sentence to imprisonment instead of transportation.

And your petitioner will as in duty bound ever pray.
