We the undersigned inhabitants of Portsea and vicinity, sympathizing with the case of Susan Edwards (who has two children, one aged four years and the other six years of age) , late of No 10 Fountain Street Landport, now a prisoner on Portsmouth Gaol convicted at the late general Quarter Sessions of the Borough before Christopher Rowbrinson Esq. and sentenced to seven years transportation for stealing two old salts value 6p the property of William Olding hereby beg to recommend her case to the notice of The marquis of Normanby Secretary of State for the Home Department in order that her sentence may be mitigated to confinement in a Penitentiary.
